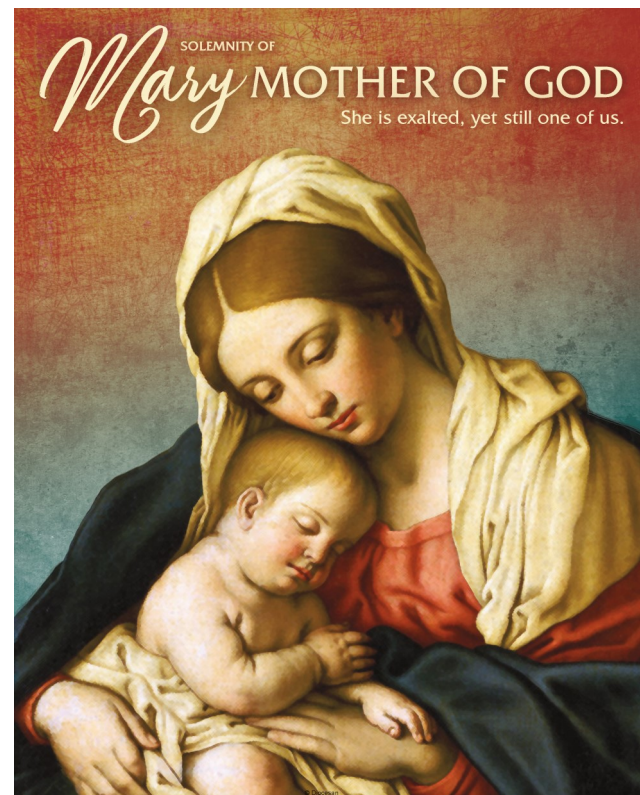

CAPITAL CAMPAIGN UPDATE

In previous Sunday's Bulletins, we noted the list of Church Restoration projects undertaken this year in Phase 1 of Our Capital Campaign, which your generous contributions have made possible; the improved sound system, the new A/C units installed, the Stained-glass windows resealed, the needed upgrade to the lighting in Church scheduled to be completed next year.

<div> <div> Solemnity of the Epiphany </div> <div> The Solemnity of the Epiphany is celebrated either on January 6 or, according to the decision of the episcopal conference, on the Sunday between January 2 and January 8. The young Messiah is revealed as the light of the nations. Yet, as the antiphon for the <i>Magnificat</i> at Second Vespers reminds us, three mysteries are encompassed in this solemnity: the adoration of the Christ Child by the Magi, the Baptism of Christ and the wedding feast at Cana. Extra candles and/or lamps may be placed around the sanctuary and in other parts of the church to honor Christ revealed as the Light of the Gentiles (<i>Ceremonial of Bishops</i>). It is customary to replace the images of the shepherds at the crib with the three Magi and their gifts. —<i>Ceremonies of the Liturgical Year</i>, Msgr. Peter J.
