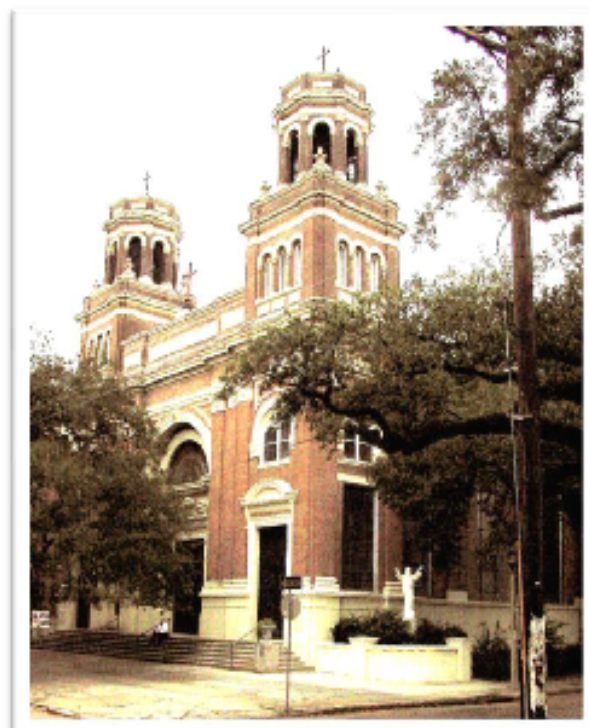

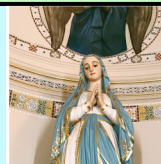


Rosary for Priests Prayer Group

Thank you for your cooperation and participation in this effort. Let us as a Church give evidence of our concern.

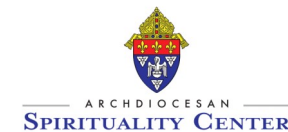

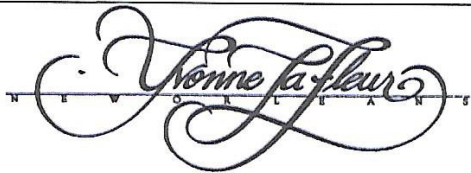
