

Step Three: Hang the ornament on the Tree.



Memorial of Saint Peter Canisius (1521-1597)

Peter Canisius, the remarkable Jesuit who almost singlehandedly reevangelized Central Europe, founded dozens of colleges, contributed to the rebirth of Catholicism by his prodigious writings, and laid the groundwork for the Catholic Reformation north of the Alps.

He died on December 21, 1597, at Fribourg, Switzerland, and was canonized and declared a Doctor of the Church in 1925.
