In Last Sunday's Bulletin, we noted the list of Church Restoration projects undertaken this year in Phase 1 of Our Capital Campaign, which your generous contributions have made possible; the improved sound system, the new A/C units installed, the Stained-glass windows resealed, the needed upgrade to the lighting in Church scheduled to be completed next year.


