Mr. Banks is a retired teacher of 33 years. The hours will be from 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM. A lunch will be served to all of those who volunteer. If you cannot work the entire day, the morning, afternoon, or even just a few hours would be much appreciated. The work will involve painting the exterior. It is recommended that you wear clothes and shoes that can get paint on them.

The paint, tools and supplies will be provided.

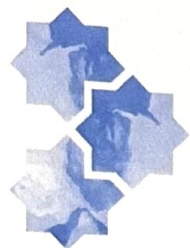

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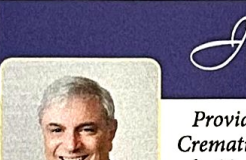

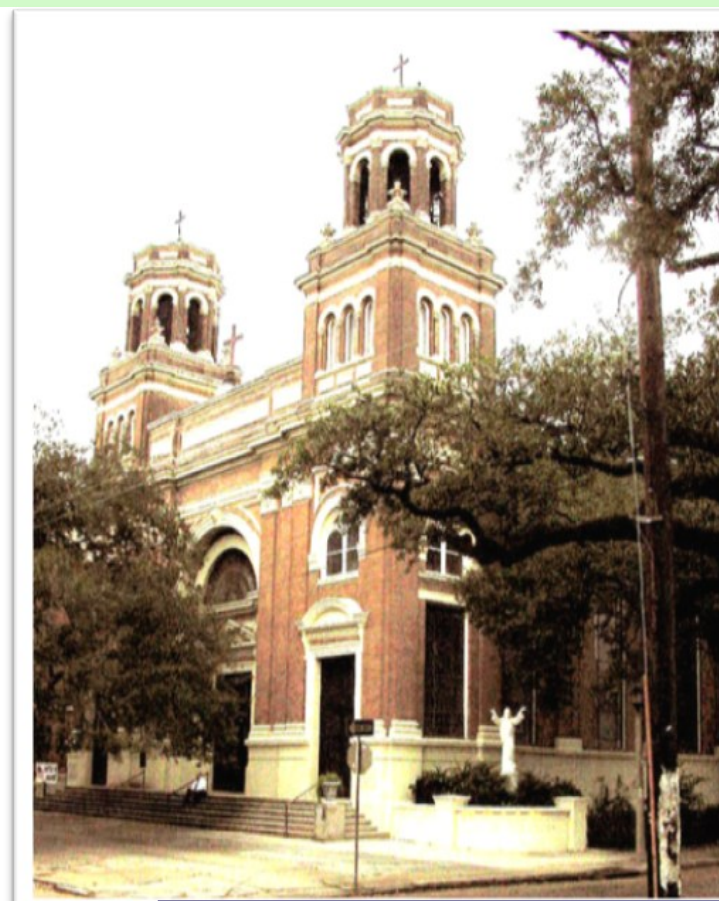
