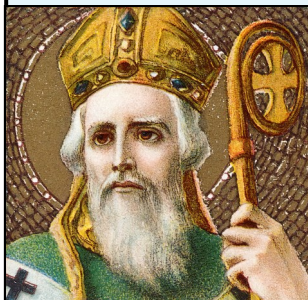
PALM SUNDAY ROSSINI'S STABAT MATER

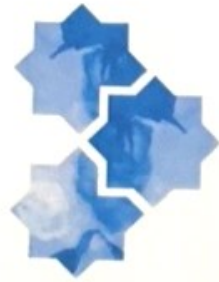
