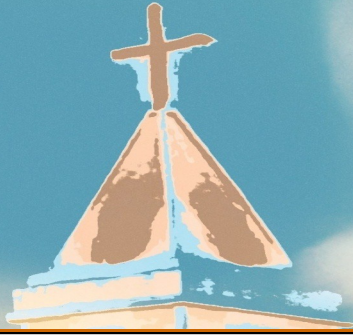

*The dates are: February 23, March 8, March 22*

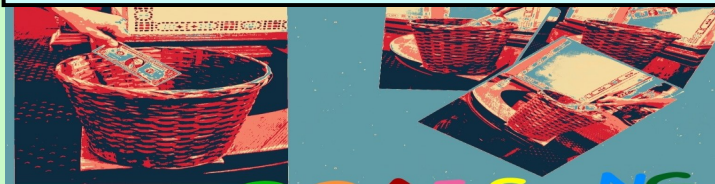
The events take place in the backyard of the church.

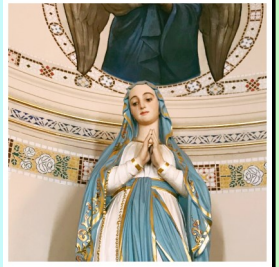
**Rosary for Priests Prayer Group**

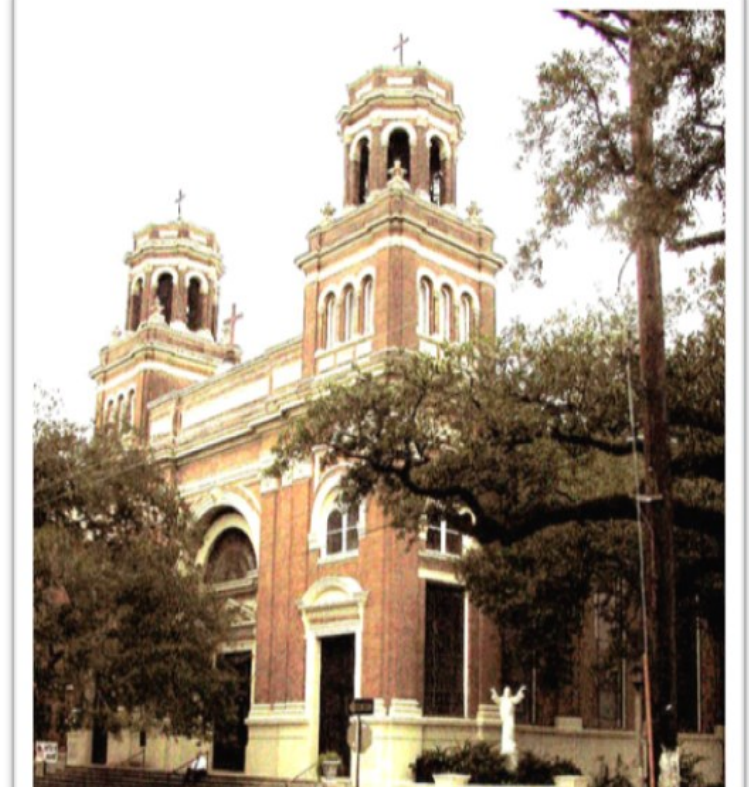
