**Rosary for Priests Prayer Group**

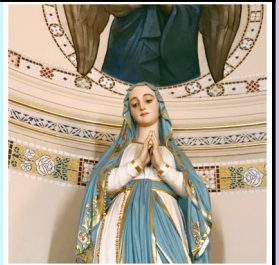
Priests need our prayers!

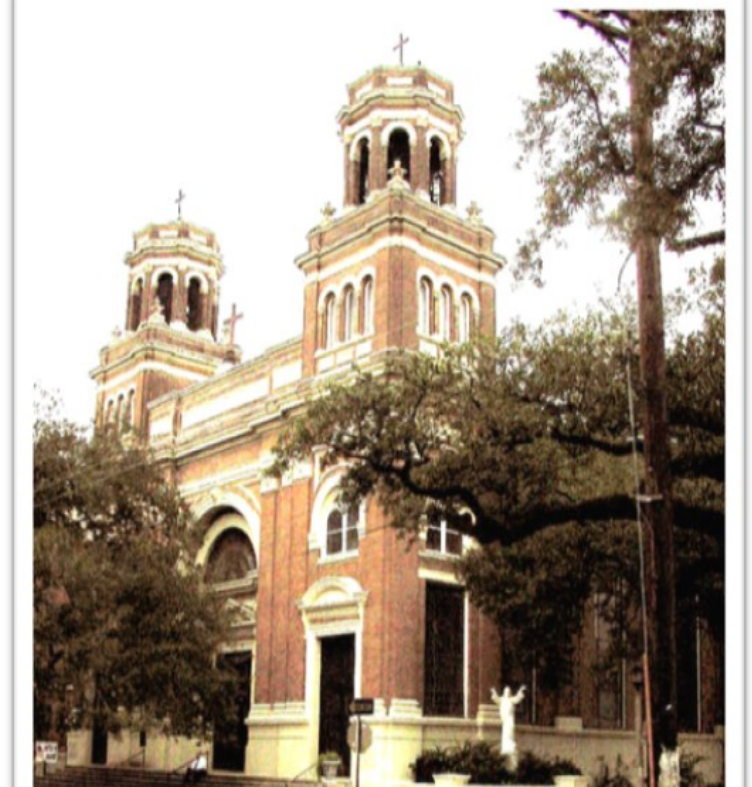
