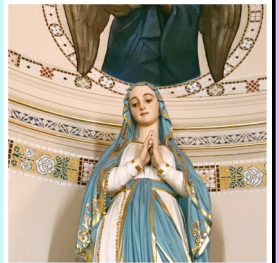
**Rosary for Priests Prayer Group**

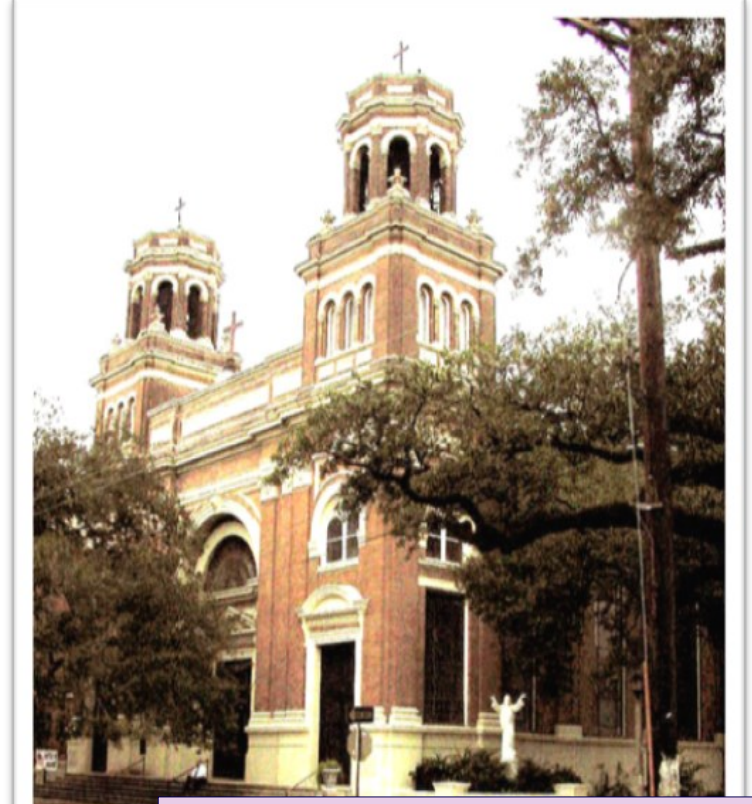
